Students that are on Varsity Football, Varsity Cheerleading, Varsity Volleyball, Varsity Swimming, or Varsity Tennis teams that would still like to be members of the band should contact Mr. JaCoby to complete the "Request for Marching Exemption" as well as each of the other forms.

J.L. MANN FALL MARCHING BAND COSTS FOR 2022-2023

FAIR SHARE:

Total Fair Share amount for all members will be <u>\$450</u> regardless of instrument or grade. You may pay the entire amount up front, or by the following deadlines:

- Deposit of \$150 due by May 31st
- Payment of \$150 due by **June 30th**
- Final Payment of \$150 due by **July 31st**

A payment plan or waiver is available to those with significant financial need. Please see the Waiver Form included in this packet. Fair Share Payments or Waiver/Payment-Plan Form must be current in order to participate in Band activities.

Total Fixed Costs Included

- Staff \$18,850
- Show \$14,490
- Props \$5,000

- Transportation \$5,500
- Scholarships \$3,000
- Maintenance/Recurring \$1,500

FUNDRAISING:

The Band Boosters have agreed to subsidize the cost per student to keep costs as low as possible. Because of this, it is the requirement that <u>ALL</u> members will <u>FULLY</u> participate in fundraisers. Please see the Fundraising Requirement form in this packet for more information.

ADDITIONAL COSTS:

The following additional costs are not included in the Fair Share. Students will be notified when to bring these monies in for orders. All costs listed are estimates. Lyres and flip folders are **required** of all instruments for playing in the stands and at pep rallies

Marching shoes \$42Lyres/Flip Folders \$10Gloves \$5

Black marching shoes and gloves are part of the full dress uniform. Shoe sizing and orders will be taken at rehearsals. The **show t-shirt** is required of all members and will be worn as part of the summer uniform at no additional cost through the Fair Share. Students are expected to provide a pair of **khaki cotton shorts** for the summer uniform. As is always the case, if you are under financial hardship, please contact either the Band Boosters or the Band Director to discuss the matter. NO ONE will be denied membership due to lack of funds. We expect this conversation to be initiated by you.

Summer Band Camps:

Summer Band Camps are all-day activities and include music, sectionals, marching, and band community building. All rehearsals are **REQUIRED**.

Regular rehearsals will begin on Monday, August 15th. Rehearsals take place as follows:

Mondays	4:30 pm - 7 pm
Tuesdays	4:30 pm - 7 pm
Thursdays	4:30 pm - 7 pm

These times mean when the students are actively rehearsing. It is up to the student to be responsible for arriving in time to be prepared to rehearse at these times.
